## Uniform System of Assessment, Examination and Report Card for classes VI- IX from Academic Year 2017-18 onwards

To increase the confidence in the students to start preparing for class X Board examination when they join the upper primary stage in class VI, the CBSE has decided to implement the uniform system of assessment, examination pattern and issue of report cards for classes VI to VIII also on the similar pattern. While keeping in view the provisions of Right to education Act, 2009 , the scheme for classes VI- VIII has been designed **on Term Assessment basis** with gradual increase in the learning assessment as the students move forward. This would prepare the students to cover the whole syllabus of the academic year and face the challenge of class X Board examination, and would thus, ensure the ‘quality of education’.

**Scholastic Area:** The assessment structure and examination for **Classes VI to VIII** have been prepared in view of the provisions of RTE – Act 2009 and **comprises of two terms** i.e. **Term -1 and 2** as explained below.

## Class IX and X Changes in CBSE System from 2017-18 onwards

**Introduction:** The Board's continued focus on assessing stipulated learning outcomes by making the examinations competencies and core concepts based, student-centric, transparent, technology-driven, and having advance provision of alternatives for different future scenarios, the following schemes are introduced for the Academic Session for Class X and Class XII 2021-22 and beyond.

The actual exposure to CBSE system starts from Class 9 onwards. Once the choice is made to enter the CBSE stream, it will be advisable to follow the same in the future course of studies.

Every year the CBSE explores possibilities of introducing newness to the system to keep pace with modern education.

For this year the following changes are to be noted.

- The syllabus is bifurcated into two terms. So the students will be tested for the 1<sup>st</sup> Term syllabus only and the same for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Term syllabus.

Portions will not be repeated for the Final Exams.

i.e 50% of the syllabus will be for the 1<sup>st</sup> Term Exam and remaining 50% syllabus for the 2<sup>nd</sup> Term Exam.

Exam + Internal Assessment = Total

Exam - 1<sup>st</sup> Term each subject = 40 + 10 = 50

2<sup>nd</sup> Term each subject = 40 + 10 = 50

Internal Assessment [Complete details will be given by respective subject teachers]

- No of Periodic Tests for the year = 3

- Multiple Assessment in classroom = 2

[Role Play / Group Discussion / Quiz / Concept Maps / Poster / Recitation / Art integrated activities / Presentations / Oral test]

- Portfolio = 2 [includes classwork and other sample of student work]

**UT – 2 = Portions of May.**

**Term 1 = Portions from April to Oct**

**UT – 3 = Portions of Nov .**

**UT – 4= Portions of Dec.**

**Pre Board = Entire syllabus given by CBSE Board .**

### Promotion Criteria

**Students who fail in two Subjects are considered failed .** They will appear as private Candidates. Students who fail in one subject can avail of only One Chance Compartment exam . Failure in this Compartment Exams will result in failure . The student will have to appear as private Candidate in March .

### Attendance

Students who have 50% attendance will not be allowed to sit for the Board Exam. This is as per CBSE rule.
